As we look forward to the coming year, we have some good news to share with you all.

IAAMJV Constitution Committee update

The IAAMJV Constitution Committee is pleased to report that our constitution has been revised and is being mailed out to all members for their feedback. The final ratification will be scheduled during IAAMJV general body meeting on July 1st in Lakeland FL. Major revision items include the creation of the Board of Trustees, Membership expansion, enhanced transparency, and fixing loose ends in the current constitution. The committee members are Chandrakant Vora, Vasant Shah, Anop Vora, and Mahendra Shah.

Updates on SMJV Hostel Projects – By Vasant Shah

Surat Girls Hostel: Basement and Ground Floor RCC work of Right-wing completed including retention wall & waterproofing. Basement and Ground Floor RCC work of the left-wing and first-floor slab for the right wing is expected to be completed by April 2023.

The Surat team is working hard to plan and complete the construction work by end of the year 2023. The Hostel Building inauguration is planned for January 2024. Admission of students will start in the academic year of 2024 after completing the furniture, fixture & utilities installation and after getting BUC (Building Use Certificate) from the local body/town.

Surat Boys Hostel: A Search for the plot of land for the proposed Boys' hostel has been initiated. Also, the modification/reconstruction of the existing D. V. Shroff Boys Hostel building is being considered for the new Boys' hostel.

Pune Boys Hostel: The construction of the new eight-floor building is already in progress. The estimated cost of the project is about Rs. 36 crores. The hostel building is expected to be completed by January 2024. Bhavnagar Boys Hostel: Half RCC slab for the second floor is completed; work for the balance half RCC slab is in progress. Brick Masonry work on Ground Floor and civil work for Basement Ramp & filling at the Basement are in progress.

A Message from JAINA

JAINA has created a JAINA Students Guidance Committee (JSGC). 1000s of the students coming to USA and Canada each year for the advanced study. The vision for this committee is to assist these Jain students, especially in the beginning of their journey. The help may be in kind of mentoring, initial hosting/setting up, airport pick up, Ride to Jain Center(s), Mentoring, grocery help, providing or helping for Jain food, etc. This initiative will help students to get connected with our community right from the start and will help them to preserve Jain values, traditions and culture. IAAMJV Loan Scholarship Programs & Donation Schemes

IAAMJV runs the following loan scholarship programs and donation schemes. All application material and information (required for the students/applicant) for the Loan Scholarship programs are available on the web, IAAMJV.org. The loan scholarship is open for any Jain Student. The student for the award is selected based on set norms and the approval process. IAAMJV has a few donors in each program and scheme listed below.

The donor may like to donate (such as in memory of XYZ) and can select the name of Trust / Fund of his choice for the donation under GoP & EF USA (both for LSGI program), EF India (LSUI program), or CEL program (for USA Students & Student Visa Holders). The donor can donate in installments. The Trust / Fund will be activated for awards after the full (specified) amount is received for the respective fund.

The details of the award including students' names and Trust / Fund names are published in IAAMJV's March and October Newsletter which is published every year.

IAAMJV is a Non-profit tax-exempt organization in the USA under IRS Code Section 501 (c) (3), ID #:11-3097675. The donation in INR in India for Endowment Fund (India) is Tax exempted under 80G. Please contact the President (email: president@iaamjv.org) or any Executive Committee Member of IAAMJV for additional information.

A. Loan Scholarship for Graduate Study in USA for Indian Students coming from India (LSGI Program)

We have increased the loan scholarship amount to \$5000 starting in Spring, 2023. We budget to award loan scholarships to a total of 60 students each year spread between Fall & Spring semesters.

- Gold Patron (GoP) Fund Donation for \$16,000 (Preferably \$20,000): Under this scheme, every year (once per year, either in Fall or Spring Semester), a recipient (one eligible student from the list of applications received) is selected by the LSGI Committee based on set norms and approval process. At present, the loan scholarship amount is \$4,000. As possible, the donor is informed of the selection of the student and award or through the newsletter. The student may also be notified that an award is possible from the subject fund. The loan amount (repayment) is re-circulated in the fund for a future award. i.e. The award from the fund can be continued beyond 4 years (considering the loan amount as \$4,000), expecting that the first or any recipient repay his loan within a 4 to 6-year period.
- LSGI Endowment Fund USA (EF USA) for \$50,000: The interest from this fund is used for the award. This fund is operated similarly to the GoP fund except only interest is used to award the loan scholarship. At present, the loan scholarship amount is \$4,000. Under this scheme, every year (once per year, either in Fall or Spring Semester), a recipient (one eligible student from the list of applications received) is selected by the LSGI Committee based on set norms and approval process. As possible, the donor is informed of the selection of the student and award or through the newsletter. The student may also be notified that an award is possible from the subject fund. The repayment is merged with the General fund.
- LSGI Loan Scholarship from General Fund: As required, the Loan scholarship is awarded from the general fund which is built up with the donation (any amount) received under the general fund.

B. Scholarship for Under Graduate Study in India for Indian Students (LSUI Program)

We award loan scholarships or scholarships (from Endowment Trust) of Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 25,000 to 40 to 80 students in India each year. The program is operated through IAAMJV Trust, Amdavad. We are trying to spread the message to the community to expand the program to benefit more students and also, to increase the award amount.

• Endowment Fund India for \$5,000: The interest from this fund is used for the award. A scholarship (and not a loan scholarship) of Rs. 25,000 is given every year to a student selected by the donor for his/her college study (generally 3 to 5 years duration, as applicable) based on set norms and approval process. The donor may select and recommend a name of a student. The student must submit his application to our Amdavad Office every year and then the donor has to inform the current President or Vice President of IAAMJV, USA with the student's name and other details. If the donor does not have any names to recommend, he may request to President / Vice President to select and award an eligible needy student from the list of applications received.

For this Endowment Fund India scheme, the donation is also accepted in India in Indian Rupees. For the same, a donation of Rs. 5,00,000 is required to open and activate each Endowment Fund. The applications/processing and other terms and conditions will remain the same as above.

C. College Education Loan Scholarship for Under Graduate Study in USA for US Students (CEL Program)

This loan is awarded to students enrolled in undergraduate or associate degree studies in any US institution. A strict selection criterion is applied to all CEL applications. Each loan amount is \$10,000 spread over 3-4 years. With tremendous support from the Jain Community of the USA, we aim to increase the number of CEL awards available. The recipient is selected by the CEL Committee based on a strict selection process.

CEL Fund for \$10,000: Under this scheme, once every year, in the Fall or Spring semester, for each CEL Fund, a scholarship grant is made to a qualified student. The recipient will receive \$5,000 in the first year, \$3,000 in the second year, and \$2,000 in the third year. Recipient students as well as donors' names are published in the IAAMJV newsletter. The loan amount (repayment) is recirculated in the fund for future awards generally after complete repayment.

Scholarships Reports

A. College Education Loans to Under Graduate US Resident Students

(CEL) –Mukesh Shah

Since 2000, CEL has awarded 67 students interest-free loans. In 2022, (6 new and 8 continuing) students were awarded this loan. The program has 37 sponsors. We thank all donors from the bottom of our hearts for supporting this program. This program is open to undergraduate college students throughout their undergraduate college enrollment. The CEL team has implemented an online application portal which has simplified the application process. Visit web site https://www.iaamjv.org/ and apply online. Refer to CEL FAQs for details. B. Loan Scholarships to Undergraduates Students in India (LSUI)

The LSUI loan scholarship program started in 1993 for Jain boys and girls in India for pursuing undergraduate, graduate, and special studies. We continue to receive a large number of applications. Every year (around September), we award about 40 to 80 students depending upon the number of applications received, and award them with loan scholarships or scholarships ranging from Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 50,000, based on their merit and need. Generally, the Academic year starts in June / July, therefore, the LSUI award is made in September/October of every year. India scholarship team is trying to promote to increase the receipt of applications (more students to apply).

The loan/scholarship recipients for the current year are listed below. It is to be noted that the student's name, listed with Endowment Fund India (EFI) awarded the scholarship.

C. Loan Scholarships to Students from India for Graduate Study in the USA (LSGI) - by Arvind Shah & Mahendra Shah

The LSGI Scholarship Committee has awarded Loan Scholarships to 26 students during the spring 2023 semester, each \$5,000 per student, totaling \$130,000. We are fortunate to award more students than average over the years. Also, we are very fortunate to increase to \$5,000/- from \$4,000/- in a short period. Since the inception (since the year 1993) of the LSGI program, we have disbursed a total of \$1,929,000 to 728 students.

Those who graduated are now working and doing very well. We are very fortunate to be in a position to help these students and see them prosper right in front of our eyes. The EC and LSGI committee & volunteers are aggressively working to contact students with outstanding loans. The loan recovery is excellent with a good response. However, we strongly request recipients who graduated before the year 2019 initiate and pay off their loans as early as possible.
