Thanks to the dedication of our current Executive Committee members and Board of Trustees, the unwavering support of fellow alumni and many supporters of IAAMJV, the last six months of 2023 have been incredibly successful. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all of you for your generous

contributions to the noble cause of education. In fact, the number of non-alumni supporters is steadily increasing significantly.

Having been a part of this organization for over 25 years, I have a deep-rooted love for its mission. My guiding principle has always been reciprocity—someone once aided me during my educational struggles, and now it's my turn to pay it back and support the cause of education.

Our most popular Loan Scholarship to Graduate Students (LSGI) program awarded record breaking 33 students in Spring 2024 semester. The loan amount has been increased to \$5,000 in 2023. A total number of students who benefited from this program has been 70 in 2023. For the Loan Scholarship for the Students in India (LSUI), the minimum loan amount is increased from Rs. 15000 to Rs. 20000, with most loan amounts increased to Rs 35000. The College Education loan program (CEL) which awards \$10,000 over 3 years has seen a modest growth as well.

Looking ahead to 2024, IAAMJV remains committed to promoting professional education within the Jain community in the USA and India. We are anticipating good growth in a number of students benefiting from all 3 programs - LSGI and CEL programs in the USA and LSUI in India. With the loan growth, we are increasing efforts for repayment of past loans. Further, we are collaborating with our India team to expand scholarship programs, slated for implementation in 2025.

Our sub-committees are operating diligently and effectively. The loan recovery team is focused on loan repayments to assist more students, the IT team is dedicated to maintaining our digital platforms, and the investment committee is making prudent financial decisions following established guidelines.



### **IAAMJV Financial Update**

### Huge Increase in Loan Scholarship budget (LSGI, CEL, LSUI)

The loan scholarship programs have been phenomenally successful and the number of students applying for loan scholarships has increased sharply. Further, the cost of education is increasing as well. To address both issues, IAAMJV has increased its budget by a whopping 90% in 2023 compared to 2022. This has been made possible by generous donations from the Jain community at large in the USA.

- The loan amount of the LSGI Program has increased to \$5,000 from the year 2023, and the number of students (loan awards) also increased from 43 to 72, representing an outlay of \$360,000 worth of loans by IAAMJV! The award will be continued for year 2024 and further.
- The loan scholarship amount under the CEL program has also increased to \$10,000 in recent years. There
  has been a remarkable increase in applications recently asking for help. Thanks to CEL team for their
  marketing and convincing efforts.
- The Loan Scholarships under the LSUI scheme for students in India program have been expanded significantly in 2023. The minimum loan amount is increased from Rs. 15000 to Rs. 20000, with most loan amounts increased to Rs 35000. In addition, the scholarships are awarded, Rs. 25,000 to Rs. 50,000 each. Another big initiative being planned is to expand the LSUI program to cover high school students, particularly, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12th-grade students. It is still in the planning stage of how to do marketing and reaching out to needy students and families. The efforts are underway to increase awareness of the LSUI program in the Jain community in all over Gujarat and surrounding states.

### **IAAMJV Loan Scholarship Programs & Donation Schemes**

IAAMJV administers the following loan scholarship programs and donation initiatives. All application material and information for the Loan Scholarship programs are available on the web, IAAMJV.org. These loan scholarships are non-sectarian and open to all Jain Students. Recipients are selected based on a strict selection criteria. IAAMJV has dedicated donors for each program and scheme listed below.

Donors can choose to donate (e.g. such as in memory of XYZ, etc.) and can select the Trust/Fund name for their donation under GoP & EF USA (both for LSGI program), CEL program (for USA Students & Student Visa Holders) or EF India (LSUI program). The donor can also pledge and pay in installments. The Trust/Fund becomes active for awards after receiving the full donation amount.

Details of the awards, including student names and Trust/Fund names, are published in IAAMJV's Spring and Fall Newsletter, as applicable.

IAAMJV is a Non-profit tax-exempt organization in the USA under IRS Code Section 501 (c) (3), ID #:11-3097675. Donations in INR in India for the Endowment Fund (India) are exempted under 80G. For additional information, please contact the President (email: president@iaamjv.org) or any Executive Committee Member of IAAMJV.

# A. Loan Scholarship for Graduate Study in USA for Indian Students coming from India (LSGI Program)

This loan is awarded to the students enrolled in graduate or higher studies in the USA. Stringent criteria are applied to all LSGI applications during the selection process. With generous support from our donors, we budget to award loans of \$5,000 each to a total of 70+ students annually across the Fall & Spring semester. Depending on fund availability in the future, we may increase the scholarship amount and or number of awards (students).

- Gold Patron (GoP) Fund Donation for \$20,000: Under this scheme, a \$5,000 loan award is made to a qualified student in the Fall or Spring semester from each LSGI GoP Fund under the donor's name. Recipients' names and the donor names are published in IAAMJV's Newsletter. The recipient is selected by the LSGI selection committee based on strict criteria. Once the recipient starts returning the loan, the amount is re-circulated for future loan awards under the donor's name.
- LSGI Endowment Fund USA (EF USA) for \$50,000: A \$5,000 loan award is made to a qualified student in the Fall or Spring semester from each LSGI Endowment Fund USA, under the donor's name. The recipient is selected by the LSGI selection committee based on strict criteria. Interest from this fund is used for the award, and the repayment is merged with the general fund.

# B. College Education Loan Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies for US Students (CEL Program)

This loan is awarded to students enrolled in undergraduate or associate degree studies in any US institutions. Stringent criteria are applied to all CEL applications. Each loan amount is \$10,000 spread over 3-4 years. A reduced amount of \$5,000 to \$8,000 is awarded, if student apply first time in third year of study or having two years of study. Depending on fund availability in the future, we may increase the number of awards (students).

• CEL Fund for \$10,000: Under this scheme, a loan of \$10,000 is made to a qualified student in the Fall semester from each CEL Fund, under the donor's name. Recipients' and donors' names

are published in IAAMJV's Newsletter. The loan amount is re-circulated for future awards once repaid.

#### C. Scholarship for Undergraduate Study in India for Indian Students (LSUI Program)

We award scholarships or loans of Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 50,000 to 60+ students in India each year under LSUI Program. The program is operated through IAAMJV Trust, Amdavad. Efforts are ongoing to expand the program and increase award amounts.

• Endowment Fund India for \$5,000: Under this scheme, a scholarship grant is made to a qualified student during undergraduate and graduate studies from LSUI Endowment Fund India, under the donor's name. The interest from this fund is used for the award. The scholarship grant amount is Rs. 25,000 per year per Endowment India fund/trust. Recipients' names and the donor names are published in IAAMJV's Newsletter.

For this Endowment Fund India, the donation is also accepted in India in Indian Rupees with a donation of Rs. 5,00,000.

#### D. General Fund (LSFR)

• Loan awards for LSGI, CEL, and LSUI programs are also made from the general fund which is built up with the donation (any amount) received under the general fund.

### C. Loan Scholarships to Undergraduates Students in India (LSUI)

The LSUI program started in 1993 for Jain boys and girls in India for pursuing undergraduate, graduate, and special studies. We continue to receive many applications. Every year (around September/October), we award about 40 to 80 students depending upon the number of applications received, and award them with loan scholarships or scholarships ranging from Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 50,000, based on their merit and need. Generally, the Academic year starts in June/July and deadline for the application is August 31. Therefore, the LSUI award is made in September/October or earlier as applicable. In year 2023, 42 students were awarded loan of Rs 15,000 to 30,000 and 21 students were awarded Rs.50,000 as scholarship from the donor advised fund (EFI). India scholarship team is trying to promote to increase the receipt of applications (more students to apply).
